Importing North America Well Analysis Tool data into PHDWin

This document explains the steps required to take data from Wood Mackenzie's North America Well Analysis Tool (NAWAT) and import into the PHDWin software by TRC Consultants.

Export data from NAWAT

Within NAWAT, from the download button top left select one of the PHDWin options for either allocated (well-level) or unallocated (lease-level where relevant) production. The data will be downloaded as a .WMC file within a .ZIP file.

For PHDWin 2.10 Build 3 onwards

Starting from 2.10 Build 3, the import of NAWAT data is a default routine available within the software. Import the saved .WMC file into PHDWin.

To import the data:

- 1. Open PHDWin and open the project that you want to bring the data into
- 2. Go to File | Import Data or Create New Cases
- 3. At the top, choose the "Import" radio button
- Click the Browse button (...) under the Import File selection
 Choose the appropriate *.wmc file
 Once you choose the file, confirm that the Woodmac import
- Once you choose the file, confirm that the Woodmac import has been selected
- 7. Then click the Finish button (screenshot on next page).

The import has been pre-mapped and will bring in the data and save it in the appropriate location.
